IN OUR HANDS - SESSIONAL SUPPORT WORKER JOB DESCRIPTION (NOV 2023)

- Are you a Creative Professional seeking a role with progression and training opportunities whilst creating change to young people in Barnet?
- Are you passionate about building trusted relationships with young people?
- Do you have an interest and experience in nails?

This role is two-fold

- Responsible for supporting the safe and effective delivery of our weekly nail bar projects, ensuring outcomes and outputs are met.
- You will be our In-house Nail Technician:
 - Ideally you will have the passion and skills to paint nails to a professional standard during sessions and our pop ups with our young people. You will also be supported with in house training to build on your personal and professional skills

ABOUT THE IN OUR HANDS PROGRAMME

"In Our Hands" programme – co-designed with young women, girls, trans- and non-binary young people – upskills participants with creative activities, starting with nail art, and leading to a range of skills relevant to the creative industries. In these community nail bars, the team of creative professionals bring skills training, mentoring and specialist support to the young people. This includes access to a Young Person's Violence Advisor, who engages with the participants to explore issues like

violence and abuse and gender equality, while responding to high-risk disclosures and supporting them to stay safe. We also deliver Pop Up Nail bars in community and educational settings.

SUMMARY OF RESPONSIBILITIES

Support the delivery of regular sessions and pop-ups;

SESSION DELIVERY

- Set up and pack down all programme activity to ensure safe, creative and engaging environments for young women
- To support the management of equipment and resources
- To help ensure the spaces and the pop-up stations are professional looking at all times
- Attend pre/debrief sessions and provide feedback on outcomes, raise issues in regard to the delivery of sessions and work with the team to apply solutions
- To support with project administration and be willing to take on other responsibility as and when they are needed
- To support with the communications for the programme, i.e posting on our social media platforms, making contact with young people

IN-HOUSE TECHNICIAN

- In-house nail technician, painting nails to a professional standard during sessions and at pop-ups.
- Teach nail training skills to young people this includes providing basic training following our in-house training programme.
- Support young people in engaging confidently in session activities and in building positive relationships with staff and peers
- Support young people in taking on leadership roles within the session, including ensuring they take a lead in creating session plans

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Take part in team meetings and planning sessions for the project where necessary
- You will work alongside the IOH Programme Manager, Senior Youth worker, trainee psychologist, Peer Leaders and other young people to create social change.
- Represent AAK, bringing the opinions of a range of young people.
- Support the AAK team wherever possible and be willing to take on other responsibilities as and when they are needed.
- Act in accordance with AAK's policies, procedures, values and ethos.
- Attend team meetings, including meetings with delivery partners as required.
- Carry out your own administrative duties as required by the role.
- To attend any essential training required by the role in order to maintain up-to-date knowledge on issues relevant to service users.
- Non-recurring duties which may arise and that fall within the remit of this post.
